Information regarding fees

It is the Gothenburg city council who make decisions regarding the fees for children who have a place in government run preschools and these are the rules that IPS also follows.

The invoice for the month we are in, will be emailed to you by the 14th of each month with the due date of the 28th of the month or if the 28th is a weekend, the closest working day to the 28th.

It is possible to pay by direct debit (autogiro) contact Melonie (melonie@ipsab.org) if you need guidance with this.

The fee is calculated as follows:

We calculate the fee as a percentage (%) of the family's (household's) gross income (income before tax). You can see the fees listed in the table above. If the household's combined income is SEK 61,560 per month or more, you pay the maximum fee: SEK 1,847 for children under three years of age and SEK 1,231 for children over three years of age.

You pay a fee for the preschool place every month, including July. This applies regardless of whether the child uses the preschool place or not.

Please note that we base the fee on the most recently submitted income information. If you do not submit any income information, you will automatically be charged the maximum fee.

If your calculated fee is less than SEK 100 per month, your invoices will be accumulated until they total SEK 100 or more. A combined invoice will then be sent to you.

You must submit an income statement

When you accept a preschool place, you submit information about the family's income. It is your responsibility to inform us of updates in your family income. You do this by emailing a new updated family income form to penny@ipsab.org

If you have several children in preschool/after-school care

If you have several children in preschool and/or after-school care, you pay the full fee for the youngest child. The fee for older siblings is reduced according to the fee table. From the fourth child onwards, no fee is charged.

Alternating residence – shared invoice

When a child lives alternately with guardians who do not live together, the invoice shall continue to be sent as before, unless we are informed of a change. Both guardians are place holders and therefore financially responsible, regardless of how custody is divided.

If both guardians use the preschool place in cases of alternating residence, each guardian is responsible for their respective share of the placement. In such cases, the child is entitled to care based on each guardian's need for care. A child is not entitled to two different preschool places.

If family circumstances change, this should be informed via email to penny@ipsab.org. If both guardians will use the preschool place, this must be reported promptly to the administration, as the place is automatically registered to the guardian with whom the child is officially registered when family composition changes.

Change in your status

If you become unemployed, start studying, or go on parental leave, you must report a change in your employment status. Employment status forms the basis for the child's placement. For example, if you become unemployed, you must change the basis for your child's placement to "job seeker" (and update your income).

If you are on Parental leave with a sibling

If you are on parental leave with a younger sibling, your children may attend preschool for a limited number of hours. You then pay a reduced fee. When you are on parental leave, your child may attend preschool for 15 hours per week, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 9:00-14:00.

- For children aged 1–2 years, you pay half the fee.
- For children aged 3–5 years, you pay no fee from September to May, but you pay half the fee in June, July, and August. (applies from the August of the year the child turns 3 years old)

If you are job seeking (must be registered with Arbetsförmedlingen)

As a job seeker, you can choose a schedule of 15 hours per week, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 9:00-14:00 or 25 hours per week 9:00-14:00 everyday.

15 hours per week

For children who are 1-2 years old and have 15 hours per week as a parent/guardian is on parental leave or job seeking the parent fee is half the normal fee every month.

For children who are 3-5 year old (from the August of the year the child turns 3 years old) and have 15 hours per week as a parent/guardian is on parental leave of job seeking, there is no parent fee charged from 1st September-31st May. In June, July and August the parent fee is half the normal fee.

25 hours per week

For children who are 1-2 years old and have 25 hours per week as a parent/guardian is job seeking the parent fee is full fee every month.

For children who are 3-5 year old (from the August of the year the child turns 3 years old) and have 25 hours per week as a parent/guardian is job seeking, there is no parent fee charged from 1st September-31st May.

In June, July and August the full parent fee is charged.

The administration carries out checks to verify that you are registered with the Arbetsförmedlingen (the employment office). In such a check, you must promptly submit a certificate from Arbetsförmedlingen. If you do not submit a certificate, the administration will assess your child's right to a place. If, according to the Education Act, there is no right to a place, the placement will be terminated.

General Preschool - Allmän förskola

General Preschool (Allmän förskola), 525 hours per year for children who are 3-5 years old (from the August of the year that they turn 3) and language preschool are free of charge.

For prolonged illness

In the case of children 's continuous absence due to illness, no fee is paid from the 22nd calendar day up to and including end of the sick period. Medical certificates must be presented.
